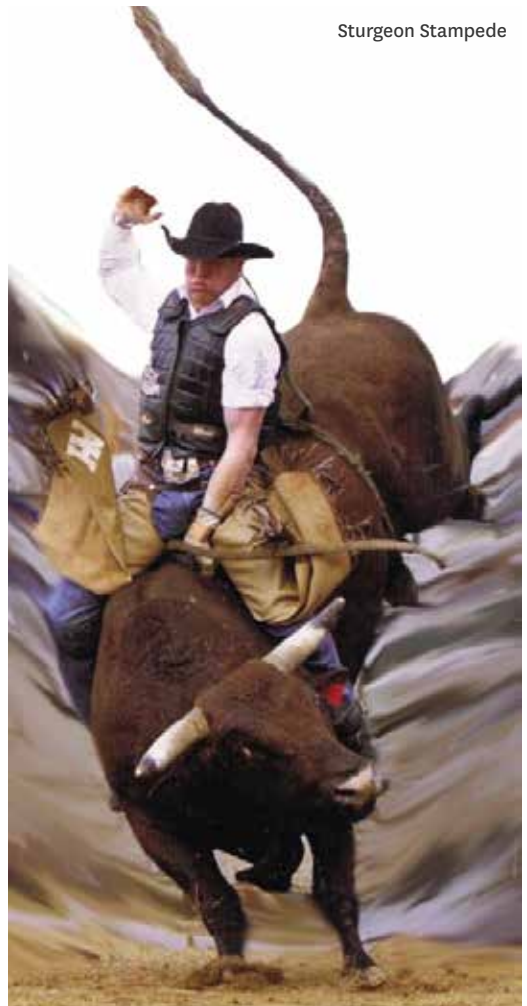

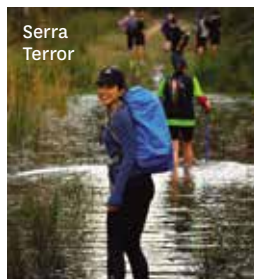

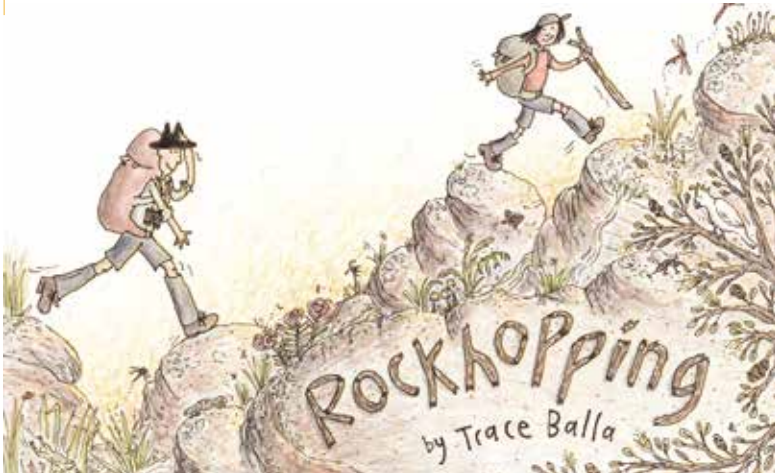

UNTIL DECEMBER Sandford and Others

As a tribute to local philanthropist Geoff Handbury, the gallery displays the painting Sandford, an Australian Homestead c. 1865 on loan from the National Library of Australia, Canberra. The homestead depicted was the property of Mr Handbury's maternal grandparents in the early 1920's and where he spent much of his childhood holidays. The painting is shown alongside other colonial scenes of Western Victoria.

UNTIL DECEMBER Australian Paintings from the permanent collection

Drawn entirely from the Hamilton Gallery collection, this exhibition presents contemporary paintings by well-known Australian artists including Rick Amor, Howard Arkley, Philip Wolfhagen, Tim Maguire and Kathleen Petyarre including some recent acquisitions.

Established in 1961, Hamilton Gallery's renowned collection features a decorative arts focus (well over half of its collection) of both Australian and International objects from the 17th century through to the present.

Asian art and Australian paintings and prints are strongly represented but the Gallery is perhaps most well known for its rare collection of gouache and watercolour pictures by Paul Sandby (1731-1809) depicting the English landscape.

The significance of the decorative arts collection and 18th century watercolours makes Hamilton Gallery a leading public art collection, Australia wide.
